Sunflower charity reveals all

A CHARITY that helps children with learning difficulties held a seminar to highlight its unique holistic approach.

The Guildford-based Sunflower Trust - which helps youngsters with a range of problems, including dyslexia, dyspraxia, and hyperactivity - recognises that learning difficulties can be a symptom of underlying imbalances and weaknesses.

Using its holistic approach these imbalances and weaknesses are diagnosed and corrected using a course of natural remedies uniquely matched to each individual.

The programme has helped thousands of children worldwide in the last decade.

At the trust's recent seminar one of the guest speakers, Dr Gerhard Otto, a Sunflower practitioner from Germany, recounted the story of how he arrived in the UK to begin treatment for his dyslexic son.

Dr Otto was so impressed with the improvements his son made that four years ago he invited members of the Sunflower team to go to Germany to train medical colleagues.

Since then around 38 medical doctors have trained in the method in Germany, Switzerland and Austria.
